(iii) Computer Science & Engineering for the
academic year 1993-94 - Regarding.**

I am, by direction, to inform you that provisional affilia-
tion has been granted to the above college for the following
courses* for the academic year 1993-94, as per the directions of
the Madras High Court in W.P.No. 19242 of 1993, subject to the
fulfilment of the following conditions@:

B.E. degree courses in -	
1) Mechanical Engineering	60 (SIXTY)
2) Electrical & Electronics Engineering	60 (SIXTY)
3) Computer Science & Engineering	60 (SIXTY)

@CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION

- 1) Each and every one of the recommendations of the *University*
Inspection Commission should be implemented;
strength
- 2) The annual intake of students/sanctioned for I Year
B.E. degree course should not exceed *ed*
- 3) The College should function at MATHUR, TIRUVANNAMALAI,
T.S.Dist. from the academic
year 1994-95.
- 4) The College should have permanent buildings and
accommodation should be made available for the
proposed courses.
- 5) The conditions stipulated by the All India Council
for Technical Education, New Delhi in its letter
No. 45-45/91-AICTE, dated 19.7.1993, shall be
fulfilled.

- 6) The provisional affiliation in the above courses ^{is} ~~are~~ granted without prejudice to the final decision of the Supreme Court of India pending in Civil Appeals against the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur;
- 7) Library should be strengthened as suggested by the Commission;
- 8) Laboratories and Workshops should be provided;
- 9) The Staff as recommended by the Commission should be appointed; subject to the stipulations of the AICTE/University;
- 10) The teachers appointed should not exceed the age of superannuation which may be prescribed by the Government/University from time to time;
- 11) The courses should be conducted in accordance with the regulations and syllabi approved by the University from time to time;
- 12) Arrangements should be made for the conduct of the University Examinations;
- 13) The Staff pattern with prescribed qualifications by the University as well as AICTE should be followed;
- 14) The candidates shall earn the required attendance prior to admission to the respective examinations;
- 15) Approval should be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff in the college;
- 16) A Librarian, a Medical Officer and a Physical Director with the requisite qualifications prescribed by the University should be appointed, immediately.
- 17) The College should not obtain donations from the students seeking admission to any course of study in the College;
- 18) The ~~concurrence~~ of the AICTE, New ~~Delhi~~ should be obtained for the college;
- 19) Scales of Pay and allowances prescribed from time to time by the Government/AICTE or by the University whichever is higher should be adopted by the Management of the College for all categories of Staff (Teaching and Non-Teaching) and furnish the details of their salaries to the University;
- 20) Suitable leave rules generally in conformity with the State Government rules should be framed;
- 21) The Management of the College should enter into an agreement with the teachers appointed as required in the conditions of service of teachers prescribed by the University;
- 22) Land and Endowment conditions must be fulfilled;
- 23) Norms & Guidelines for opening of Engineering Colleges (Volume I & Volume II) should be complied with;

- 24) A copy of the Sale Deed for effecting the purchase of land should be sent to the University;
- 25) The College should collect Tuition and other Fees from the students at the rates prescribed by the Government;
- 26) An Endowment of Rs.50 lakhs (Rupees fifty lakhs) should be provided out of which Rs.25 lakhs (Rupees twentyfive lakhs) should be in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt invested in a Nationalised Bank or Scheduled Bank in the joint names of the Registrar, University of Madras and the Management of the College and the balance endowment of Rs.25 lakhs may be shown by the Management of the College in the form of property. This should be in the form of un-encumbered assets fetching an annual income of about Rs.3,00,000/-. Both the income i.e., annual interest from F.D.Receipt and annual income from the un-encumbered assets should be spent only for the maintenance of the College;
- 27) All further conditions of affiliation as laid down in Chapter XXVI of the University Calendar, Volume I, 1985 as amended should be complied with;
- 28) Such other conditions as may be prescribed by the University from time to time should also be complied with;
- 29) If the conditions of provisional affiliation granted are not complied with, Statute 44-A of Chapter XXVI, Volume I, 1985 of the University Calendar would automatically be enforced.

I am also, by direction, to request you to kindly note that the University grants provisional affiliation to this college in the above* courses for the academic year 1993-94 reserving the rights of the University of Madras to file a Writ Appeal in the High Court of Madras on the order of the High Court of Madras passed in the aforesaid Writ Petition.

In communicating the above, I am, by direction, to request ^{The Management} you kindly to let me have a detailed report regarding the fulfilment of all the above conditions of affiliation for the academic year 1993-94.

It may also kindly be noted that no admissions should be made to all the above courses for the academic year 1994-95 until specific permission is granted by the University.

I am, further, by direction, to request ^{The Management} you to kindly forward to this University urgently a Fixed Deposit Receipt for a sum of Rs.25 lakhs (Rupees twentyfive lakhs) in the joint names of the Registrar, University of Madras, Madras-600 005 and the Management of the above college.

I am also to inform ^{The Management} you that an application for affiliation to II Year B.E. degree of the above courses should be made before 30.11.1993 for the academic year 1994-95.
