Sub: Proposal for starting Arunai Engineering College at Mathur,  
Thiruvannamalai, Tamilnadu.

Sir,

I am directed to state that in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras WMP No.24317/92 in Writ Petition No. 16163/92 and based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the AICTE has granted approval for establishment of Arunai Engineering College at Mathur, Thiruvannamalai, Tamilnadu for conduct of the following Degree Courses with annual intakes indicated against each during the academic year 1993-94 only.

- Mechanical Engineering	60 (sixty)
- Electrical & Electronics Engineering	60 (sixty)
- Computer Science & Engineering	60 (sixty)

This approval is also subject to the following conditions:

1. The infrastructural and other facilities should be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time and as recommended by the Expert Committee of the AICTE.
2. The admissions should be made as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE as adopted by the State Govt. of Tamilnadu and no Capitation fee should be charged in any form from the students/Guardians of the students.
3. The accounts of the Institution should be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant and will be open for inspection by the AICTE or any Board or Person authorised by it.
4. The teaching and other staff should be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by AICTE from time to time.

5. The AICTE scales of pay should be paid to the teaching faculty.
6. The intake in any of the approved course should not be altered under any circumstances without the prior concurrence of the AICTE.
7. No new courses should be started under any circumstances without the prior concurrence of the AICTE.
8. The Management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

The College should obtain the approval of the Government of Tamilnadu and affiliating support from the University of Madras before starting the course.

The Management of the College should submit to the AICTE Delhi, a duly registered undertaking confirming its willingness to fulfil the conditions laid down by the AICTE latest by 31st August, 1993.

This approval is also subject to full compliance of the SCHEME laid down by the Supreme Court of India in its judgement dated 4.2.1993 in WP(C) No. 607 of 1992.

An Expert Committee of the Southern Regional Committee of the AICTE will visit the Arunai Engineering College by the end of academic year 1993-94 to review the progress made in compliance with the conditions laid down by the AICTE.

In the event of non compliance by the Trust and/or the College the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and all the consequent liabilities will solely be that of the University/Institute.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate steps to implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the progress made in this regard to the SRC of the AICTE and to this office.
