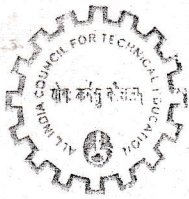

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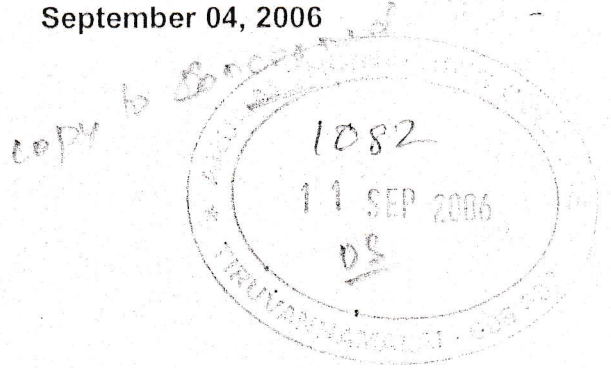

Opportunities for improvements as suggested by the Members of the Expert Committee who visited the institution for assessment for accreditation are placed below :

Programme : Mechanical Engineering

- Poor R & D activities and less publication of papers.

Programme : Computer Science & Engineering

- Sponsored projects from industry has not been taken up.
- Research and development related work is very rare for inhouse as well as external agencies.

Programme : Electrical & Electronics Engineering

- Faculty participation in departmental and institutional development needs improvement.
- % of students appearing and qualifying in the competitive exams is less.
- Personality development initiatives needs strengtheningBudget for R& D activities does not exist
- Industrial sponsored projects hardly exist.
- Initiative for consultancy and testing should be taken

Programme : Electronics & Instrumentation Engg.

- Personality development initiatives needs to be strengthened.
- Budgetary provision for inhouse R& D activities required to be established.
- Industrial sponsored projects lacking completely
- Activities of consultancy & testing have to be initiated
- Students project work has to be upgraded.

Programme : Information Technology

- Adequate efforts are not taken for R&D activities
- Less number of publications and no patents.
- No consultation and testing activities.
